**Pedestrian crossing construction and temporary
partial road closure, Timari Street
(weather permitting)****New pedestrian crossings – Timari
Street**

As part of the Timari Street Streetscape project two new pedestrian crossings are being constructed to help make the precinct more pedestrian friendly and assist with traffic calming.

The two pedestrian crossings are located at the northern and southern ends of Timari Street (adjacent to Mischief Hair and Beauty and the Northshore Tavern, and Lifeline and the Northshore Tavern).

The first crossing to be constructed will be southern crossing, between Lifeline and the Northshore Tavern.

To construct this crossing safely and efficiently it is necessary to temporarily close a section of Timari Street to vehicle traffic, namely the southern access to and from David Low Way. Pedestrian access will remain available to Timari Street.

Vehicle access to Timari Street will remain available via Menzies Drive and the service lane during construction.

The project team will ensure the maximum number of car parking bays remain available in Timari Street as is safe and practical to do so.

Please refer to the map attached with this notification to see the pedestrian crossing locations, the area of the temporary road closure and alternative vehicle access points.

The temporary closure will take place from:

**5am Monday 5 February – 7am Monday 12 February
2018** (weather and site conditions permitting).

Detours and signage will be in place to help communicate the temporary changes to motorists.
